## The world's

 largest palacePeople like big buildings. Many rich and famous people build big and expensive houses. Kings have big houses, too. The houses of kings are called palaces and castles.

The biggest palace in the world is in Bucharest. Bucharest is the capital of Romania. The name of the palace is the Palace of the Parliament and Romanian politicians work there today.

The palace in Bucharest is 84 metres high and has a surface of 365,000 square metres! There are more than 1100 rooms in the palace on 12 floors. People say that there are many floors underground - a minimum of eight. This is a lot of space. About 70\% of the rooms are empty.

A team of 700 architects designed the palace and about 20,000 people built it. It took 13 years to finish the building. We know that the building is very expensive because today its cost is 4 billion euros.

The building is very heavy because it weighs 4.10 million tonnes. Only one building in the world is heavier: The Great Pyramid of Giza. If you visit Romania, you can go inside the Palace of the Parliament. One ticket costs about 7 euros.
